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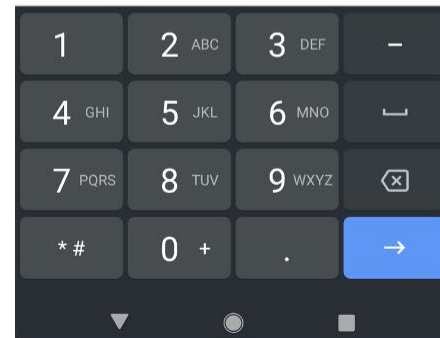
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PROJECT TIMELINE: DEI PROJECT - PLAN + IMPLEMENT



DEI PROJECT PARAMETERS

1

Impacts a DEI Metric (see Guide)

2

Justified by data - will impact / improve health equity post-COVID

Can be SDE/upstream approaches, access to care, process improvements like data dash

3

2 Types of Funding -

\$500 to \$1500 - Potential for supplemental funding or financial support for training, coaching, depending on the project

4

Plan due to SCHA Sept. 1, 2022

Don't have to IMPLEMENT but let us know plan via email

5

5X5 Late September Presentation

Will receive peer feedback to incorporate into plan.

FUNDING FOR HOSPITAL PROJECTS



MINI-GRANTS - SCHA/ALLIANCE GRANT FUNDS

\$500 to \$1500 per hospital

Must relate to capacity building or improvements in 1 of 4 Domains

No food, etc. - federal dollar restrictions

HEALTHY PALMETTO FUNDING - CLINICAL/COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

Guidance provided during 1:1 meetings thru July

Physical activity, healthy eating, etc.

- 1 Vision/Goal Statement
- 2 Priorities
- 3 Rationale
- 4 Strategies/Tactics
- 5 Current Actions + Next Steps

5X5 PRESENTATION

5 Slide Presentation that simply explains your DEI Project at your hospital
